


ITINERARY

DAY 1 ARRIVAL INCHEON - BUSAN (DINNER)

Upon arrival at **Incheon International Airport**, you will be provided with a private transfer to **Seoul Train Station** and you will be taking the KTX train to Busan (approx. 2hrs 15min).

Once you reach Busan, you will be picked up and proceed to today's main highlights:

- · Jagalchi Market: It is the largest fish market in South Korea and a must visit destination for seafood lover. Lunch will be at your own expense.
- · Gamcheon Culture Village: Filled with beautiful colourful streets, which are popularly featured in K-dramas.
- · Busan Tower (lift ticket is not included): The 120-metre-high tower overlooks Yongdusan Park and get a panoramic view of Busan port.

You will be enjoying dinner at a local restaurant specialising in "Sundae Gukbap", which is a popular Korean dish consisting of Korean sausage soup and rice. Tonight, you will be staying in the Moving Caravan Busan (Gamsung Caravan).

DAY 2 BUSAN (LUNCH)

After breakfast on your own, you will be proceeding to today's attractions:

- · Haeundae Beach Train: Enjoy a panoramic view of Eastern Busan as you sit on any one of the colourful sky capsule.
- · Chengsapo Daritdol Observatory: A 72.5-m-long ocean observation pier in the shape of a blue dragon, with village & lighthouse views.

Lunch will be at local restaurant called "**Dongnae Milmyeon**", popularised by BTS members who enjoyed the wheat noodles here. After lunch, you will have free time to shop to your heart's content at **Nampodong Street**. Dinner will be on your own.

After breakfast at the hotel, you will be transferred to Busan Train station to take the KTX train back to **Seoul**. Upon arrival, you will be taken to lunch to enjoy Korean ginseng chicken soup before spending the rest of the day at your leisure.

- · Byeolmadang Library in Starfield COEX: The iconic library is one of the largest in South Korea, housing over 50,000 books.
- The Blue House (drive by): The Blue House was the official residency of the South Korean President.
- Seaweed Museum (inclusive of Hanbok experience): Get the experiences of wearing Hanbok and capture some insta-worthy shots in the background of the Seaweed Museum.

In the evening, you will be treated to a full course traditional Korean meal which is known as "Hanjeongsik" for dinner.

DAY 1 ARRIVAL INCHEON - JINAN - JEONJU (LUNCH / DINNER)

- **Gyeonggijeon Shrine:** Erected in 1410, it holds the portrait of King Tae-jo, the founder of the Joseon Dynasty. The structure was partially destroyed during the Imjin War (1592-1598), and the existing structure was remodeled in 1614.
- Jeondong Catholic Cathedral: This cathedral was built in honor of Roman Catholic martyrs of the Joseon Dynasty on the very same spot the martyrs lost their lives.

For lunch, you will be enjoying **"Bibimbap"**, which is a one-bowl rice dish with various condiments mixed together. In the evening, you will be dining on traditional Korean full course meal called **"Hanjeongsik"** before spending the evening at your leisure.

DAY 3 JEONJU - BORYEONG - SEOUL (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Today is the day you've been looking forward to - Boryeong Mud Festival.

After breakfast, you will check-out from the hotel and transfer to Boryeong. Today's main highlights are:

- $\cdot \textbf{Gaehwa Art Park:} \ \text{The world's largest Sculpture Park, which is a spacious theme art park that houses a variety of parks and attractions.} \\$
