DAY 1 ARRIVAL INCHEON - JINAN - JEONJU (LUNG LOINNE

- Jeondong Catholic Cathedral: This cathedral was built in honor of Roman Catholic martyrs of the Joseon Dynasty on the very same spot the martyrs lost their lives.

For lunch, you will be enjoying "Bibimbap", which is a one-bowl rice dish with various condiments mixed together. In the evening, you will be dining on traditional Korean full course meal called "Hanjeongsik" before spending the evening at your leisure.

DAY 3 JEONJU - BORYEONG - SEOUL (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Today is the day you've been looking forward to - Boryeong Mud Festival.

After breakfast, you will check-out from the hotel and transfer to **Boryeong**. Today's main highlights are:

- Gaehwa Art Park: The world's largest Sculpture Park, which is a spacious theme art park that houses a variety of parks and attractions.
- **Zip Trek:** At a height of 20-storey building, take in the scenic view of the horizon ahead of you as you zip line towards Daecheon Beach.
- Boryeong Mud Festival: This event has grown to be one of the biggest festivals in Korea, attracting the largest number of international visitors to Daecheon Beach. During the festival, visitors flock to the area to experience the benefits of Boryeong's mud while having a blast.

Lunch will be a Boryeong classic consisting steamed clams and noodles while for dinner you will digging into DIY teokbbokki. After a fun-filled day at Boryeong, we will be heading to Seoul for a final bit of sightseeing.
